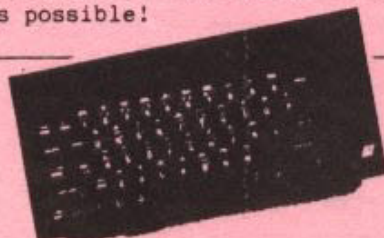

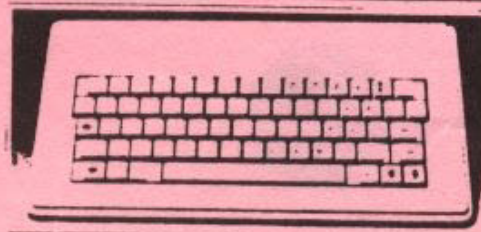

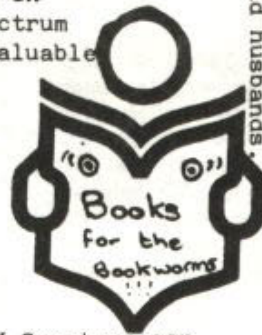

Having recently acquired a full-width printer, I can now do these items for the newsletter via Tasword. So as a starter, I'll pass along some of the lessons I have learned that may be value to others converting to a big printer.

First of all, I have a Smith-Corona Fastext 80 which is coupled to the computer via Peter Hacksel's printer interface and software. The latter is generally acceptable in that it works as he says it should. But the way it performs the TAB function is poor and generally useless with my programs that rely on TABbing for good displays. Also, my printer is not Epson compatible and therefore his programs for lo-res and hi-res screen copying will not work. Lo-res screen copying can be accomplished using a routine that I show below and which Charlie Urban provided.

When it came to adapting Tasword to this printer, I found that following the manual and some notes by George Chambers made it relatively easy and I soon had the graphics keys adapted to the SCH printer.

So, I have Elongated on graphics key 1; Condensed on key 2; Underline on key 3; keys 4, 5 and 6 are unused for now; Elite and Pica (normal) are on key 7; and Form Feed is on key 8 (caps).

These graphics characters have to be embedded into the text as you type it in to Tasword. I found it handy to have a crib sheet so I drew one up and here it is. The first two lines show the actual codes used with each graphic character. I keep mine on a cork board just ahead of me as I use Tasword.

PAGINATION

Paging some long text gives a better appearance and I experimented with ensuring a top and bottom margin on each page.

I found it relatively easy to paginate by using a crib sheet which is an alternative to using the form feed graphic character. Here is my crib sheet:

PAGINATION CRIB SHEET

PAGE	START LINE	END LINE

This works for my paper which is 28 cm or 11 inches long (ie, between perforations.)

I start all printing with a perforation line just even with the top of the print head. This usually means leaving in the previous page and tearing it off later.

Using form feed embedded in the text will cause the paper to feed out automatically up to the next perforation line according to the predetermined page length, which just happened to be right for my page length. However, it is possible to set the page length to another value but the printer defaults to 66 lines on power up or reset.

One thing I learned early in the game was that when calling for elongated printing, it is important that the print head be at the left margin at the start of printing. Otherwise, the print head will move to the left and cause a crash (on the paper and in Tasword). This is corrected by powering down the printer and then powering up again. The print head (carriage) will be at the left margin and the printing should go according to plan.

Here is the short routine to print the screen display in lo-res. It will not print graphics, though.

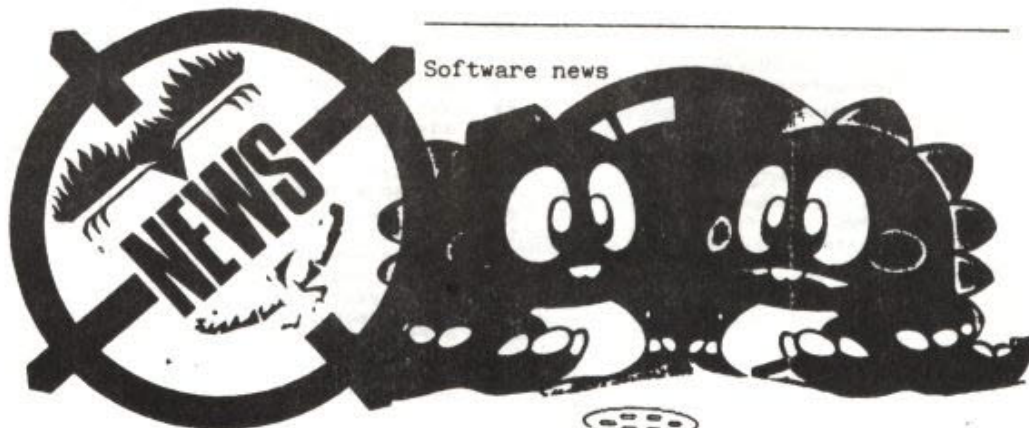

command. This has 8 arguments, all of which are obscure. The only way to produce something vaguely melodic is by trial and error. The following quickie allows you to do exactly this.

BACKUPS

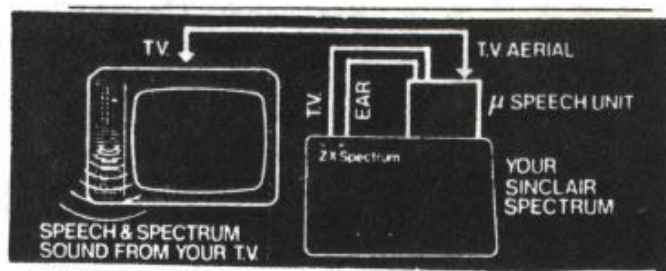

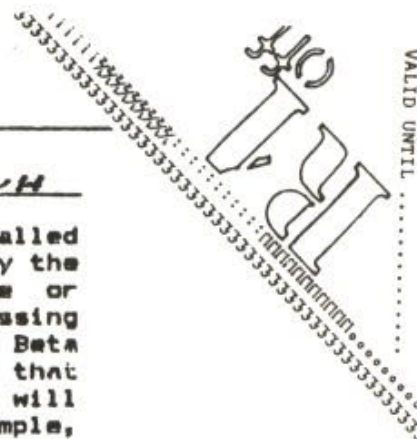

Program to TASWORD III : by GvH

This program written in Beta Basic 3.0 will create a file called "listing" containing a program listing that can be loaded by the TASWORD III word processor. So enabling you to view, change or print the program listing using the special word processing capabilities of Tasword. You will need both Tasword III and Beta Basic 3.0 as well as a Microdrive. Also keep in mind that program listings should not exceed line no 8999 as this will overwrite the program below. To use the program is quite simple, type in the listing below, then merge the program you wish to convert. Now put your TASWORD III cartridge in drive no 1 and simply type EOTO 9000, and wait. As soon as the drive has stopped and "File Converted" appears on the screen you can load TASWORD III and load "listing". The listing below was printed by TASWORD III, I used RENUM 9000 TO 9320 LINE 9960 STEP 1, to shift the listing and changed line 9963 to LIST #5; TO 9959. I have exaggerated the indenting and used plenty of REMinders as spacing to enhance readability, these may be omitted.

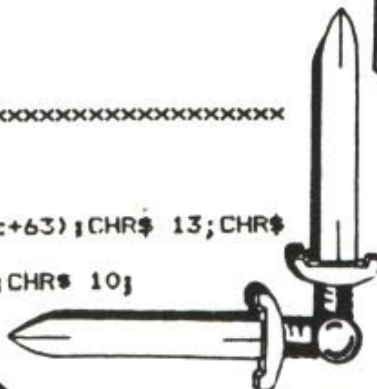

NOTE:-

From Translate 2 to 8 I have put in brackets the first command as SHIFT/CRL followed by the key. I cannot use the actual command key because I am using this driver and to do so would cause the printer to shift to the mode the command key calls for. So with these entries you just press Shift and Ctrl together with the command key, and the appropriate symbol will appear in the driver instruction.

Having installed the above by using Function key 5. Access the Quill Boot program.

I recommend you modify this on the cartridge on which you install this driver, so you don't get screwed up with a standard Quill. To do so, access Boot, renam and then alter as per listing.

QL TOOLKIT

I recomend you add this program to the TOOLKIT by Dan Fitgibbons (MAY '87). This program adds the following commands to the QL's vocabulary.

ON_ERROR	<i>ON_ERROR command\$</i>	Will execute command\$ when an error occurs. eg. ON_ERROR "beep 100,20" will cause the computer to beep every time a error occurs.
dec	<i>dec hex\$</i>	Will convert hex\$ into decimal. eg. PRINT dec "ff" will display 255.
look	<i>look startaddr</i>	Will display the contents on memory in the form address, Peek address and CHR\$ PEEK address.
lookw	<i>lookw startaddr</i>	Same as for look as well as the Peek_l and Peek_w. Pushing a key will make it continue, pushing "b" will make it go back.
sys	<i>sys</i>	Lookw at the system vars .

The main feature of this toolkit is the **ON_ERROR** command. One negative point of this command is that the error and the command is displayed on #0. You will understand why this is when I explain how the **ON_ERROR** command works. I found the following addresses without refering to any other book (except the QL manual), only by using the routines in this toolkit. The **ON_ERROR** command can be typed in without the other routines and it will work on any mode.

#0 has a type ahead buffer (you can see this if you type a command in while a program is being executed then this will be executed when the program stops). When you use the **ON_ERROR** command it POKES your command into the buffer, then when a error is produced it executes your command. The QL uses your command as if it had been typed in. This is why it displays your command.

You can stop the printing problem by setting #0's ink the same as it's paper. Do not attempt to close #0, it might cause the system too crash!

Do not type in the text in italics.
